

October 9	1855 - Isaac Singer patented his <u>sewing machine</u> . The first functional <u>sewing machine</u> was invented by Barthelemy Thimonnier in 1830, and he was almost killed by enraged French tailors because they felt threatened by his invention.
October 10	1911 - <u>Henry Ford</u> received a patent for an automobile transmission mechanism.
October 11	1841 - A patent for a collapsible tube for use with such items as toothpaste was granted to John Rand.

International News:-

On October 10, Russian missiles rained down on Kyiv and other cities across Ukraine in the biggest wave of strikes in months



Several explosions were heard on October 17, 2022 morning in Kyiv, exactly a week after Russian missile strikes on the Ukrainian capital, *AFP* journalists said. Three blasts occurred between 6:35 am and 6:58 am (0335 GMT and 0358 GMT). Air raid sirens sounded shortly before the first explosion. The attacks killed at least 19 people, injured 105 others and sparked an international outcry. Moscow carried out further strikes on October 11, though on a smaller scale, striking energy installations in western Ukraine far from the front. Russian President Vladimir Putin said the strikes were in retaliation for an explosion that damaged a key bridge linking Russia to the Moscow-annexed Crimean peninsula. Putin on Friday had expressed satisfaction and said there was no need for further massive strikes on Ukraine "for now".

National News:-



A portal showing status of dumpsites, remediation plans under Swachh Bharat likely in November

Preparations to complete one of the targets of the **Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) 2.0** that was launched a year ago – the remediation of all legacy landfills in the country – are in full swing and a public dashboard on the progress at 2,200 such sites is in the offing, Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry officials said. Launched on October 1, 2021 by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the mission aims at making all cities “garbage-free” by the end of its five-year period. An official said action plans for 1,000 legacy landfill sites had been approved by the Ministry, with each having a different timeline for completion. The process of reconciliation of the details of all such sites was on and the online dashboard that would be launched in November would contain the exact number, size and remediation plans of the sites, which are estimated to be around 2,200, the official said. These “sizeable” landfills each contain at least 1,000 tonnes of waste. The preparations for all the sites would be completed in this financial year, the official added.
