According to the above reference letter, RKL under Rule 3.1.3.2 and 3.3 of the Secondary School Code. RKL Galaxy International School operated by Galaxy International School Foundation, Vadmukhwadi, Tal. Haveli Dist. Pune .Letter No2 to the English medium class of the secondary school. As per 2, permission was given to the classes from 1st to 12th from primary to higher secondary from June 2017. Now your reference letter no. Due to non-compliance with the 3rd recommendation, etc. 9th and. For 10th year 2018-2019 June 2018. Etc. Your reference letter no. For English medium classes of 9th and 10th. Taking into account the clear recommendation given by 3. The first approval is being given for a new English secondary school.

1. Vigilance to ensure that the provisions of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 are not violated in the present case. Should take.
2. New classes are first recognized on a self-help basis and in the future any grant as well as No any financial assistance will be provided.
3. Strict adherence to RARV provisions in Rule No. 3 (2), 48 and 83 of the Secondary School Code.
4. Teachers should be appointed as per prescribed norms.
5. Confirmation and staff approval should be done every year.
6. Tuition fees should be charged following the prescribed procedure.
7. Students should be admitted within the prescribed number limit.



8. It will be mandatory to follow the orders and instructions given by the government from time to time.
9. The first approval is temporary and the office will consider giving permanent approval after a period of five years. However, the school should continue to fulfill the conditions laid down in the Secondary School Code Rule No.3.
10. No changes may be made in the future in the medium and school premises etc..
11. Where the government has given permission. If a school is started in a place other than that place, the permission given by the government will be automatically considered revoked.
12. Permission to set up a school as per the provisions of the Act will be from the academic year 2017-2018.
13. In the academic year 2017-18, classes other than those which are allowed cannot be started.
14. It will be mandatory for the new schools to comply with the provisions of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 and the Maharashtra Self-Aided Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act-2013.
15. For the information of all the public, it will be mandatory to put up a sign in the front of the school building indicating that the English medium new secondary school / class is allowed on self-financed basis.
16. A school approved under the Maharashtra Self-Aided Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 cannot be relocated in future.
17. Schools permitted under the Maharashtra Self-Supporting Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 will be required to register separately as self-financed schools / classes while filling in the information in U-Dise.
18. To enforce the existing rules of the Government and the rules which the Government may prescribe from time to time. Will remain binding.

Other terms:

Fulfilment of the following matters as per the order given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 14.04.2009 in Public Interest Litigation No. 483/04 Should do.

1. Firefighting systems should be installed in schools within six months.
2. Flammable and hazardous items should not be kept in the school building.
3. Necessary training should be given to the concerned staff of the school and other staff on the use of firefighting system.



4. The school building is safe from all points of view and also under the (National Building Code of India)The Education Officer (Secondary) Zilla Parishad, Pune should ensure that the school building is constructed as per the standards.
5. Every school building should be inspected regularly for safety reasons. Strict disciplinary action should be taken against the officers / staff who do not do the above work.
6. Right to Free and Compulsory Education of Children Act 2009, Maharashtra Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011 as well as the criteria and conditions prescribed by the Board to which the school is to be affiliated.
7. It is mandatory to abide by the Maharashtra Educational Institutions (Fees Regulation) Act 2009 and Rules 2016.

Recognition of the school may be continued subject to fulfilment of the above conditions and conditions to be determined from time to time and subject to satisfactory performance. Should take.

Education Officer (Secondary) Zilla Parishad, Pune should consider the progress of the school during the next inspection and consider continuing the recognition.


